Phase 2 Design Your Journey

Design. Included in the design are: Pre- and Post briefing, air and ground travel, accommodation, meals, facilitation and any 'touristy' options.

Not included in the quote: Passport, visa(s) and inoculations (if required).

Details. The average Leadership Journey will entail 8-10 participants being away for 8-10 days in duration. This is spread over 2 weekends so that you are only away from your desk for 5 working days.

Travel costs. Costs vary depending on location and the time of year you intend to travel. We can give you a quote once you have chosen a location and we have helped you design an itinerary with a rough set of dates. Leadership Journey will cost between \$4,000 and \$8,000 per person all inclusive.

There may be a shared component of travel and facilitation costs between the participants and their employer.

What we do. Our experienced travel team will look after the logistics for you including: Travel tickets, visas, accommodation, travel insurance and tourist activities. We will let you know what inoculations you need to procure (if any).

Agreement on a sum of money to be raised for the development project in the six months following the Journey by the participants.

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Phase 3 Experience the Journey

Full day Pre-Briefing at your work site at least a fortnight before we travel. We will begin to explore a number of learning themes for the Journey as well as preparing you practically in terms of what to expect and what to pack.

The Journey itself will usually be 8-10 days including the return travel. Our emphasis will be on building relationships and immersing the group into new tastes, sights, modes of transportation, language, culture and hands-on activities.

Half day debrief within a fortnight of returning home. Wrap up the Journey and preparation for phase 4.

Day 1 - 3 Depart Australia. Arrive at overseas country destination. Undertake orientation. Rest and acclimatize. Travel to accommodation nearby chosen Project.

Day 4 - 7 Briefing on project context with NGO staff. Visit project and related community programs, undertake a range of cross-cultural leadership and community oriented activities. Daily de-briefs. Prepare and engage in community event. Farewell to NGO staff, Project team and new friends.

Day 8 - 9 Enjoy tourist activity and Leadership Journey team dinner. Undertake Project reflection and team discussion.

Day 10 Travel back to Australia. Leadership Journey travel component ends.

Phase 4 Growth and Advocacy

Participants will 'Champion' the project they have visited by raising a pre-agreed sum of money within a six month period.

Group coaching will take place approximately once each month for six months to track the advocacy phase and to measure changes in practice and the development of leadership competencies and influence within your organisational context.
